DIVISION A. RACING - No Post Entries except to fill heats.

- All terriers including 4 up to 6 month puppies, must be muzzled.
- Basket Muzzles preferred. No open-ended muzzles. No bright colored muzzles. Collars should be off when on deck.
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- No request for height measurement once racing has begun. Measurements by 7:45 AM
- Terriers May Not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran & Senior classes.
- To be eligible to run in the Championship race, the terrier MUST have entered and FINISHED in both flats and hurdles classes. A terrier that is not entered in both classes and has not run in both classes is not eligible to run in the championship race. In this case, the second place terrier becomes eligible to run in the Championship race, assuming it was entered and ran and finished in both classes.

Class 42: Over 12½-15" Veteran Championship. Open to 1st place winners of classes 15, 17, 36, 38. No entry fee.

DIVISION B: CONFORMATION

Section I: YOUTH

- Child Handlers 5-9 years of age. They must handle a six month or older Jack Russell terrier.
- Youth Handlers: 10-16 years of age. <u>The youth handler must handle the same adult terrier</u> in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please. See rules for exceptions regarding injured terrier.
- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year; except for those children turning 5 years of age. They may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5th birthday.
- Child/Youth entries must be JRTCA members either under a family membership or under an individual Youth membership.
- Entry fee is \$12.00 a class. Please list class number, child/youth's name, birthday, and dog's name on entry form.
- Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Points are: 1st=8 pts., 2nd=6 pts., 3rd=5 pts., 4th= 4 pts., 5th=3 pts., 6th= 2 pts., & Participation=1 pt.

<u>Class 43:</u> Child Handler. Open to any youth aged 5 through 9 handling a JRT, six months of age or older. Judged on child's knowledge of the JR and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 44:</u> Youth Handler. Open to any youth aged 10–16 handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's knowledge of the JRT and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 45:</u> Youth GTG. Open to any youth aged 10-16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's ability to present his or her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through the 10-ft. novice liner; time not to be considered.

<u>Class 46:</u> <u>Youth High Score and Reserve</u> will be awarded to the Youth Handlers with the most points in Classes 44 thru 45.

CONFORMATION

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes <u>must submit the appropriate JRTCA Paperwork with entries</u>. The
 judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of
 judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.

Class 53: BEST DOG PUP & RESERVE. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 51 & 52. no entry fee.

Class 56: BEST BITCH PUP & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 54 & 55. no entry fee.

<u>Class 57</u>: <u>PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE</u>. Open to Best Puppy Dog & Reserve and Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve, class 53 & 56. no entry fee.

Section IV. Family

<u>Class 58:</u> Stud Dog & Get. Open to sire with at least 2, but not more than 3, offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.

<u>Class 59:</u> Brood Bitch & Produce. Open to dam with at least 2, but not more than 3, offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.

Class 60: BEST FAMILY. Open to first & second place winners of classes 58 & 59. No entry fee.

Section V. Miscellaneous.

Open to any adult JRT including those spayed and neutered. Judged on breed standard unless otherwise noted. <u>Class 61:</u> Veteran Dog. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier dog six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition of dog.

<u>Class 62:</u> Veteran Bitch. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier bitch six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition of dog.

Class 63: BEST VETERAN. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 61 & 62

<u>Conformation continued</u>-Miscellaneous

Class 64: Spayed/Neutered Adult. Open to any spayed/neutered adult.

<u>Class 65:</u> Companion. Open to all JRTS. Judged on companionship, cuteness, personality, obedience and tricks. Not to be judged on breed standard, non-sanctioned.

Suitability.

Judge's Choice. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each of the quarry listed below.

Class 66: Suitability to Red Fox

Class 67: Suitability to Groundhog

Class 68: Suitability to Raccoon/Badger.

<u>Class 69: BEST SUITABILITY & RESERVE</u>. Judges choice for the most suitable all-around working terrier. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of Classes 66, 67 & 68. (non-sanctioned)

Section VI. JRTCA Working Terriers. Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA NHC. Terriers entering this section may not cross enter in Open; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working section.

Class 70: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over

<u>Class 71:</u> Bronze Medallion Dog. Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 72: Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over, 10 up to 121/2"

Class 73: Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15"

<u>Class 74:</u> Veteran Working Terrier Dog, 6 years and over.

<u>Class 75</u>: <u>BEST JRTCA WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 70 through 74; no entry fee.

Class 76: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over

<u>Class 77:</u> Bronze Medallion Bitch. Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 78: Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over, 10 up to 121/2"

Class 79: Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 80: Veteran Working Terrier Bitch, 6 years and over.

<u>Class 81: BEST JRTCA WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 76 through 80; no entry fee.

<u>Class 82: JRTCA WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 75 & 81. No entry fee.

Section VII. Open Adult. No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section.

<u>Class 83:</u> Bred by Exhibitor Dog. Open to any adult JR owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 84: Dogs, 1 year & over, 10 up to 121/2", smooth

Class 85: Dogs, 1 year & over, 10 up to 121/2", rough/broken

Class 86: Dogs, 1 year & over, over 121/2" up to 15", smooth

Class 87: Dogs, 1 year & over, over 12%" up to 15", rough/broken

Class 88: BEST OPEN DOG & RESERVE. Open to first & second place winners of classes 83-87. No entry fee.

Conformation continued-

Open

<u>Class 89</u>: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch. Open to any adult JR owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 90: Bitches, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 91: Bitches, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken

Class 92: Bitches, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15", smooth

Class 93: Bitches, 1 year & over, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken

Class 94: BEST OPEN BITCH & RESERVE. Open to first & second place winners of classes 89-93. No entry fee.

Class 95: BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE. Open to first & second place winners of classes 88 & 94. No entry fee.

DIVISION C—GO-TO-GROUND

• Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. See posted rules at event.

• *FOR ALL CLASSES; work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself.

Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached, for all classes.

• Must work quarry continuously for one full minute, without a break in work, unless noted.

• No Adult terrier may compete in the Championship Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for and issued and received.

Please be courteous; Let someone run between your dogs when you have more than one.

• <u>Copies of JRTCA GTG trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries</u> or presented to the den steward at the time of judging in all championship classes.

 Open Puppy & Open Adult, Puppy & Adult Championship classes-1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry.

• Cross-entering is not permitted between open or certificate classes.

<u>Class 96</u>: **Pre-Novice Puppy**. Open to pups 4 up to 6 mos. Entry in this class does not affect pup's eligibility to enter Novice class after 6 mos. of age. One min. to reach quarry; mark for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached.

Class 97: Novice Puppy. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

<u>Class 98:</u> **Open Puppy**. Open to JRT's 6 up to 12 months <u>which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground</u> class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. <u>Not open to any pup which has previously achieved 100% in this class</u>. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial <u>may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial</u>. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

GTG continued

Class: 99: **Puppy GTG Championship**. Open to JRT pups 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% on Open Puppy G-T-G at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of the 100% score sheet must be submitted with a preentry or shown to den steward at the time of the class. Puppies may move up to this class on the same day as qualifying in Open G-T-G, upon payment of additional fee. 1st. and 2nd. Place winners will be Puppy G-T-G Champion and Reserve. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

<u>Class 100</u>: **Novice Adult**. Open to JRTs one year or older <u>which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial</u>. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial <u>may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial</u>. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

<u>Class 101:</u> **Open Adult.** Open to adult JRTs <u>which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial</u>. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. <u>May not move up to championship classes until certificate is in hand.</u>

GO-TO-GROUND CERTIFICATE CLASSES – NO CROSS ENTERING

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 15" who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Copy of certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1 second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

First and second place winners will be GTG Champion & Reserve.

Class 102: 10 up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate

Class 103: Over 12½ up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate

Class 104: 10 up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate

Class 105: Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate

Class 106: 10 up to 12½" Senior Championship Certificate.

Class 107: Over 12½ up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate.

DIVISION D — **SUPER EARTH**. Challenging GTG course; open to any JRT 6 mos. or older. <u>All Super Earth</u> <u>classes-1 second per total feet of tunnel</u> to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until the quarry is reached; then must work quarry for one minute a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty. Copy of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging.

Class 108: Open Puppy Super Earth 6 up to 12 months

<u>Class 109: Open Adult Super Earth.</u> Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 110: Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

<u>Class 111:</u> 6 up to 12 month Puppy Champion Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 months JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 months Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. <u>First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.</u>

Super Earth continued

SUPER EARTH CERTIFICATE CLASSES-- NO CROSS ENTERING

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. <u>First and Second Place winners will be Super Earth Champion and Reserve.</u>

Class 112: 10 up to 12.5" Adult Certificate Super Earth.

Class 113: Over 12.5" up to 15" Adult Certificate Super Earth

- 1. ALL SANCTIONED CLASSES ARE OPEN TO JACK RUSSELL TERRIERS ONLY.
- 2. EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS OF TERRIERS ENTERED MUST BE CURRENT JRTCA MEMBERS AND NOT BE A MEMBER
- OF A CONFLICTING JRT ORGANIZATION OR REGISTER THEIR JRTS IN ANY ALL-BREED REGISTRY. IF AN EXHIBITOR IS FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY, ENTRY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN. IF A VIOLATION IS CONFIRMED AFTER THE TRIAL, PLACEMENTS WILL BE VOIDED FROM ALL JRTCA RECORDS. EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT A COMPLETED ENTRY FORM INCLUDING A SIGNED WAIVER FOR EVERY TRIAL THEY ENTER.
- 3. ENTRIES MUST BE WITHIN THE 10 15" JRTCA HEIGHT STANDARD (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PUPS WHO HAVE NOT YET MET THE 10" HEIGHT STANDARD); MEASURING DEVICES WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE TRIAL GROUNDS.
- 4. PUPPIES (UNDER 12 MONTHS) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A CHAMPIONSHIP IN ANY DIVISION BUT THEIR OWN. PUPPIES ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE ONLY IF THEY HAVE REACHED THEIR FOUR-MONTH BIRTHDAY (NOT 16 WEEKS). A PUPPY'S AGE IS THE ACTUAL AGE THE PUP IS ON THE DAY OF THE TRIAL.
- 5. BITCHES IN SEASON MAY NOT COMPETE IN ANY DIVISION. PRE-ENTRY FEES OF BITCHES IN SEASON WILL BE REFUNDED WITH A VETERINARIAN CERTIFICATE, OR AS OTHERWISE AGREED UPON BY THE TRIAL CHAIRPERSON.
- 6. SPAYED OR NEUTERED TERRIERS MAY COMPETE IN MISCELLANEOUS CONFORMATION. THEY MAY NOT COMPETE IN PUPPY, FAMILY, OPEN OR WORKING CONFORMATION. *NOTE: FOR FAMILY CLASSES; BROOD BITCHES & STUD DOGS ENTERED MAY NOT BE SPAYED/NEUTERED. THE OFFSPRING AT THEIR SIDES MAY BE INTACT OR SPAYED/NEUTERED.
- 7. A TERRIER BRED BY A SANCTIONED JRTCA JUDGE MAY NOT BE SHOWN UNDER THAT JUDGE IN THE CONFORMATION DIVISION.
- 8. TERRIERS OWNED OR CO-OWNED BY THE TRIAL CHAIRPERSON, OR ANY MEMBER OF THEIR HOUSEHOLD, MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN ANY PHASE OF THE COMPETITION, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CHILD AND YOUTH HANDLING CLASSES.
- 9. TERRIERS OWNED BY JUDGES MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN THE DIVISION IN WHICH THEY ARE JUDGING; BUT MAY ENTER THE COMPETITION IN ANY OTHER DIVISION.
- 10. TERRIERS OWNED BY STEWARDS MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY DIVISION PROVIDED THAT THEY FIND A SUBSTITUTE TO PERFORM THEIR DUTIES OR HAVE SOMEONE ELSE SHOW THEIR TERRIERS.
- 11. REQUESTS FOR THE MEASUREMENT OF A TERRIER ENTERED IN ANY CLASS NUMBER MAY BE MADE ONLY BY ANOTHER EXHIBITOR IN THAT SAME CLASS NUMBER OR BY THE JUDGE EXCEPT IN RACING. REQUESTS FOR THE MEASUREMENT OF A TERRIER IN RACING MAY BE MADE BY THE JUDGE OR BY AN EXHIBITOR WITH A TERRIER ENTERED IN THE SAME CLASS NUMBER OR, IF CLASSES ARE SPLIT BY GENDER, MAY CALL FOR THE MEASUREMENT OF A TERRIER IN THE SAME AGE AND HEIGHT CATEGORY. (EXAMPLE: THE OWNER OF AN UNDER ADULT DOG ENTERED IN RACING MAY CALL FOR THE MEASUREMENT OF AN UNDER ADULT BITCH AS THE POTENTIAL EXISTS FOR THEM TO RACE EACH OTHER IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP RACES.) - 15. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED OR CRATED EXCEPT WHEN COMPETITION REQUIRES OFF-LEASH WORK. NO LIBERTY LEASHES ALLOWED.
- 16. OVERLY AGGRESSIVE DOGS, OR AN OWNER'S FAILURE TO CONTROL THEIR DOG, MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGES OR THE TRIAL CHAIRPERSON.
